Fee-based income/fee rules and application rules

The fees for enrollment in a childcare center and after-school care are based on the household's total gross income (income before tax) per month (annual income divided by 12) regardless of whether or not the child/children are in the joint custody of the adults living in the household. The child's order of birth (among his or her siblings) and the type of care facility (childcare or after-school care) provides the starting point for the calculation. Child number 1 is the youngest child in the household. For households with an income under SEK 8,000 per month, no fees are charged. The local authorities are entitled to verify the parents' income information and may also ask the parents to provide proof of income.

Income from business activity only pertains to income from activity and/or passive business activity that is taken up on the main tax return. This is what shall be included as part of the household's total gross income. Income from work overseas or from foreign-registered employers shall be included, provided that it is income to the joint household.

If the child/children live with both parents/guardians and both require a placement for the child/children in childcare/after-school care, each, individually, shall be a placement holder. The fee is calculated on the basis of each household's income. A co-habitant, who does not share custody of the child/children belonging to the guardian in the household, is not obliged to pay maintenance for the child/children. However, when calculating the fee, each person's income (the co-habitant and the guardian) shall be included.

Any change in income must be reported without delay. Please use the website for reporting such changes www.karlskrona.se and then click on självservice/barnomsorgens webbtjänst. At that point, you can activate the Google Translate feature to guide you through the process in other languages. To login, you will need an electronic ID (BankID). The maximum fee will be charged if no income information is provided. Repayment and settlement against prior reported income is only applied, at most, one month retrospectively. There is an administration fee of SEK 200.

Each year, kunskapsförvaltning (a local authority administrative unit) checks its information against what has been reported to the Swedish Tax Agency on household's fee-based income. Fees are then adjusted, accordingly. Please note that this can only be done once the tax returns for one year have been completed.

There are special fees for care provided during the school breaks. Furthermore, the fees for school breaks during the period September-May, differ from the fees charged for care during the summer months of June, July and August.

As of the fall term when the child reaches 3 years of age, the fee is reduced by 30% for public childcare centers during the period September-May, 15 hours/week.

Fees are charged 12 months of the year, which means that fees are charged during vacation and other periods of leave.
