

## **Admissions policy**

All admissions to Swedish upper secondary schools are carried out by the Department of Education (kunskapsförvaltning).

Every student in grade 9 of the compulsory school can apply between January 15 and February 15. Login codes will be handed out by the school's study counsellor. Students from other countries need to contact the Swedish Admissions Office:

Adolescents can apply at the latest in the spring term of the year they turn 19.

**We welcome all students who fit the above requirements to apply to the EGIC at Ehrens värdska gymnasiet to get the broadest possible range of students.**

### **Requirements for EGIC-applicants**

- passing grades in twelve subjects. These must be achieved in Swedish, English, Maths, Biology, Physics, Chemistry and six more subjects.
- MYP4 students and those from other countries are not required to know Swedish
- students from other countries hand in officially translated grades
- a guardian to the student needs to live nearby
- good written and spoken English
- a letter in English where the student motivates his or her choice of the EGIC and a CV
- interview with the DP Coordinator
- prepskill tests in English and Mathematics

### **Requirements for second year**

- grades from EGIC or MYP5 (with a completed Personal Project) or grades from equivalent 10 year education
- good written and spoken English
- interview with the DP Coordinator
- prepskill tests in English and Mathematics
